JOB DESCRIPTION

If you would love to share your film-making skills to help ethnic teams in Asia, we have just the right role for you! The Global Trainer role is a voluntary position with Project Video Asia. The main focus is on developing the movie-making skills of an ethnic video team who would be looking for guidance and training as they step into video ministry. A video trainer will usually run training sessions online for ethnic teams using our existing curriculum (which is available at <https://pvasia.org/training-resources>) or by creating their own curriculum. There may also be opportunities to visit the ethnic team to provide in person training.

SKILLS REQUIRED

- The ability to teach over Zoom
- Videography skills - teaching basic camera settings such as ISO, shutter speed, aperture, camera movement, lighting etc.
- Video editing skills - generally using either a smartphone app such as Kinemaster or a program like Da Vinci Resolve.
- Experience in video-making in genres such as documentary, preaching, testimony, music videos, short films.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Training online in basic subjects such as smartphone film-making, basic DSLR camerawork and video editing.
- Committing to two hours of training per week, for one year.
- Following up with your ethnic team about their progress and homework.
- Following the training schedule given.
- Keeping in touch with the PV Asia Training Team regarding your ethnic team's progress and development.
